GENERAL CONDITIONS

- 1. In addition to a Road Cut Permit (Form NHD-007) the permittee shall also obtain and meet the requirements of a Utility Permit (Form NHD-001).
- 2. A permit fee and deposit in the amounts shown in the current Highway District fee schedule is required.
- 3. Permittee is soley responsible for the pavement cut, excavation, backfill replacement, compaction test and asphalt repair. All work shall be per *Highway Standards & Development Procedures* for the Association of Canyon County Highway Districts. Asphalt repair shall be a minimum of 3 inches thick with a minimum of 10 inches of ¾ inch road mix immediately under the asphalt.
- 4. Permittee shall call Highway District for final inspection when work is finished.

- 5. If within ten (10) days from start of road cut construction the work is completed to the satisfaction of the Highway District and final inspection is called for, then the deposit will be refunded. Otherwise, the deposit will be forfeit and the Highway District will contract the work to be completed by other means.
- 6. All Highway District costs to finish the work will be billed to and paid by permittee.
- 7. Permittee shall submit a schedule and traffic control plan for the closure and the opening of the roadway. If the work obstructs emergency vehicles, school buses, or U.S. Mail delivery, then permittee shall notify those those entities of same.
